

6th Annual Thomasville Rotary Club Chili Cook-Off



Come and join us for the 6th Annual Chili Cook-off at Thomasville's Pace Park (Farmer's Market). This is a perfect venue to support your community AND promote your company or group. We welcome all participants to bring your promotional materials, banners, signs, flyers, etc. so you get the maximum exposure for YOU at this event.

All profits from the event go to support three great local organizations: CCM, The Father's Storehouse and CIS.

Event Guidelines

All teams must register by the deadline (Form enclosed – deadline is October 10th).

- A team is comprised of at least two people
- Teams may check-in and set up on Saturday, October 19th by 9:00 am. All vehicles must be clear of the cooking/serving area by 10:00 am. Teams will not be allowed to dismantle and leave until the end of the event.
- Each team will be assigned a space (minimum 12' x 12'). Team is responsible to bring their own chairs, tables and shelter for their cooking area.
- Each team is required to bring a minimum of five (5) gallons of chili.
- The chili may be cooked from scratch on site or prepared off site and served at the event. It is the team's responsibility to be able to serve hot chili. Electricity will be available, but cords will not be, so come prepared to plug in your own stuff. (If you do need electricity, let Jarrod know when you register, as there are limited spaces available with electricity.)
- All teams are expected to prepare, cook, warm and serve their chili in a sanitary manner.
- All cooks may be required by the judges to eat a spoonful of their own chili. If the cook will not eat it, then we cannot serve it, and the judges will not eat it either.

Prizes: 1st Place – Trophy and \$250
2nd Place – Trophy and \$100
3rd Place – Trophy and \$50
