FAQs

What qualifies someone to join Rotary? A prospective member must be in good standing in the community and be a business owner, an executive, manage their own time, or be in a managerial position to be eligible for membership.

How does an individual become a Rotarian? To join, you must have a sponsor. Your sponsor will invite you to a lunch meeting where you can meet other Rotarians and experience a Rotary meeting.

Where does Rotary meet? The Rotary Club of Morrisville meets each Tuesday at noon in the <u>Prestonwood Country Club</u>, Cary, N.C.

What are the current financial obligations of belonging to Morrisville Rotary?

What do I receive for my dues? You will receive a subscription to the <u>Rotarian</u>, Rotary International monthly journal, weekly meal at the <u>Prestonwood Country Club</u>, service to our community, and networking opportunities.

Are there minimum attendance requirements? To remain in good standing, a 50% attendance record is expected. Meetings missed are easy to make up at other Clubs, world-wide. Attendance at regularly scheduled committee meetings, board meetings, new member orientations, Club social functions all count as a meeting. Additionally, you can make up a missed meeting by attending other Rotary Club meetings two weeks prior or two weeks after a missed meeting.

What is the New Membership process? Your Sponsor will ask you to complete a prospective Member Application and return it. Upon receipt, you will be notified by email. The Application will be submitted to the Board for consideration. Upon approval, you will be notified immediately. As soon as scheduling allows, you will be introduced to the Club by your sponsor during a regular Tuesday Club lunch meeting. At this meeting, you will receive your Red name badge.

Is there a New Member Orientation? The Rotary Club of Morrisville is committed to help new members find their place in the Rotary World, availing all aspects of service to better the world around us. Our Club's New Member Orientation will follow a regular Rotary meeting with a New Member Packet filled with information about the Club.

Are prospective members ever turned down? Prospective members can be turned down because the Membership Committee or the Board of the Club feels that he/she does not meet the qualification for membership..
