Program

Karen presented Dexter Green, a Navy veteran, and a former member of the Elizabeth City Police Department. Dexter spoke on NC Gun Laws, including the Stand Your Ground Law. As a NC certified instructor since 2009, he is eminently qualified to speak on this topic. One of the issues that he spent a good bit of time on was the concealed carry permit and the laws associated with it. As he noted, concealed carry pertains to a short stock gun that can be handled by one hand. While explaining NC gun laws, he referenced at least one difference with VA gun laws where retreat is always required, if possible. Regarding a home invasion, he stressed that protecting property alone is not sufficient reason for using lethal force. He provided a great deal of information, but noted that anyone wishing to get a concealed carry permit can take his class at Chauncey's on the 3rd Saturday of each month.
