#### Program

Frank presented this week's program on the current situation around the world in getting Polio under control. As in the past, the incidence of Polio is relatively low with most cases in Afghanistan and Pakistan. However, as Frank noted, Polio is only one flight away from infecting people in other countries. To stay on top of the situation, hundreds of millions of children must be immunized annually to keep the situation under control. He also noted that Polio Plus means that mosquito netting and small business loans are available for those already suffering from the horrible effects of Polio.
