Micki introduced Christopher Barcliff, a financial advisor with Edward Jones & the Hertford Rotary Club Foundation investment advisor, who spoke on the topic of 'What drives the market during times of international unrest & how to deal with the stress.' He started his presentation with a short audio/visual clip from a larger presentation. In it we learned that Edward Jones has 8 million clients & they have offices around the country. A concern for most people is their ability to maintain & ultimately transfer assets to the next generation. They recommend that clients consider their market risks when choosing investments, their goals, and the need for taking emotions out of the decision-making process (which is where an advisor can be especially helpful). Chris explained that people need to stay focused on their long-term goals & not get overly excited about market fluctuations. Historically, the market corrects itself. In the end, we need to have faith that things will get better.
