#### Program

Tim introduced Jackie Greene, Director of the Perquimans County Board of Elections. Jackie moved here 2 years ago after spending 15 years in Charlotte. Past work experience included teaching for 30 years. She began by identifying the 7 voting precincts in Perquimans. The largest is Bethel with over 3,000 voters (note: their future voting location will be in the PC Rec. Center instead of the Ruritan Bldg.). Currently, there are 2 municipal elections coming up (one in Hertford & the other in Winfall). The mayoral positions and town commissioners are on the ballot for those living in those jurisdictions. Early voting begins on 10/19 & continues through 11/4. Currently, photo IDs are required to vote. Lacking proper ID, an individual can vote provisionally, but must present acceptable ID within 10 days for their vote to be accepted. As of January 2024, the Board of Election office will move to Winfall.
