

Mental Health & Wellness

A key initiative is Mental Health & Wellness and to that end, the district has created a task force of members and local mental health professionals to build a sustainable plan that will assist members and their communities with; erasing stigma associated with discussions of emotional well-being; raising awareness of mental health needs; and improving access to mental care services.

Through community partners we will reach a deeper and broader audience in the Cape Fear Region. Additionally, through local partners, we provide Mental Health First Aid and QPR training for our members and their families.

An annual weekend retreat that provides intensive leadership experience where high school students develop skills as a leader while having fun and making connections.
