- Conduct a comprehensive member satisfaction survey.
- Create or update club strategic plan.
- Assign 7 of 9 listed club officers for 2023-24 in DACdb by July 31, 2023 (President, President-Elect, President-Nominee, Secretary, Treasurer, Membership Chair, Foundation Chair, Public Image Chair, DEI Chair).
