Coastal Pender Rotary Club is pleased to announce that applications are now available for the 2023 Coastal Pender Rotary Club's Financial Assistance Program for Education.

- ♦ Applicants must live in the Topsail School District catchment area.
- Applicants may be a current student or have graduated from Topsail High School or a student or a graduate of an accredited home school program or a Charter School, or a returning adult student.
- ♦ One-year grants can be awarded for any course of study at an accredited educational facility College, Technical Institute, Trade School, Business School, Training facility
- ♦Up to a maximum of four (4) \$500 grants will be awarded.
- Finalists will be asked to meet with the Selection Committee to discuss their application.

**Applications are available** at the Topsail High School Guidance Office and on the Coastal Pender Rotary Club website: www.coastalpenderrotaryclub.com. A completed application form is the only written requirement for submission.

#### Coastal Pender Rotary Club Financial Assistance Program for Education

- The Financial Assistance Program will use the term "Award" to describe the process and what the dollar amount is called that will be provided to an applicant. The term "Award" vs. "Scholarship" offers a wider interpretation of who (not necessarily a current high school student) and is given for what will be achieved in the future as opposed a reward for past achievements.
- For an individual to be eligible to submit an applicant for an Award he/she must be a resident residing
  within the Topsail High School catchment area. Secondly, he/she must be a current student or graduate
  of Topsail High School or a current or a graduated student completing an approved home school or
  Charter School curriculum.
- The total amount of *financial assistance* that can be provided each year will be *determined by* the amount
  that is approved for the *Financial Assistance Award line-item in the annual budget*. The available
  amount may vary from year to year.
- Awards Committee will be responsible for providing information and recommendations for the Financial Assistance Award line-item for each annual budget.
- Disbursements will only be paid to the school's Financial Aid Office/Business office on behalf of the Award recipient.
- An Award commitment will be for one year. A recipient may make other applications in future years, however, applications submitted in subsequent years will be considered strictly on its own merits and will be viewed on an equal basis with first-time applications.
- An Award Committee will be charged with interviewing each applicant and selecting an applicant or applicants that will be recommended to the club membership for approval. Where deemed appropriate more than one applicant may be recommended for approval, however, the total amount that could be dispersed is not to exceed the budgeted line-item amount for that year. The interview requirement is viewed as crucial to the entire process as it will allow interviewers and applicants an opportunity to become better acquainted and to address other questions as they might arise.
- Between an application form and a personal interview, certain areas of interest will be explored to include:
   a listing of what other funding sources have been/will be contacted; family information including number
   of family members, siblings in school, any special issues faced; personal involvement in school and/or
   community activities; why the specific career path or course of study was chosen and personal expectations
   upon completion of this education.
- Applicants may request funding for any career path or course of study of his/her choice.
- To be eligible to receive a Financial Award the applicant must attend an accredited educational facility.
- Public announcements relating to application submissions will be disseminated through: Topsail High School Guidance office and Faculty; local community and fraternal organizations; churches; newspapers; and social media posts.
