## PROGRAM LAST WEEK by Bob Byrne



The Executive Director of the August Regional Airport (AGA), Herbert Judon presented an audience friendly overview the operation. The AGA has a yearly budget of \$18 million; a capital budget of \$24 million that it uses to the advantage of a reciprocal relationship between airport operations and community interests. The airport has a \$300 million dollar annual impact on the local economy while at the same time depending on the health of that local economy for future growth. Under the vision, "Advancing Growing Stronger" Herbert Judon brings 19 years of prior experience from leading the Charlotte Douglas airport in Charlotte, NC. His vision focuses on customer centric projects. To

date these include adding two new passenger boarding bridges with two more planned for the near future, upgrading restroom appearance and sanitation, and adding convenience features to the terminal such as charging stations for electronic devices and private rooms for nursing infants. He has even added a K-9 bomb dog to enhance security.

Carrier service has also been improved. In March of this year new service to the Dallas Fort Worth Airport was initiated. By January 2020 service once provided to Regan National in Washington DC will be restarted. These should enhance the growth of operations that have doubled in the past ten years and in 2018 serviced 613,000 passengers or approximately 1000 passengers each day originating from AGA. Future plans in Mr.Judon's vision for AGA include improving the radar system to provide redundancy and courting another "legacy" carrier in addition to the current trio of US Air. Delta and American Airlines.
