

## PROGRAM LAST WEEK by Tara Reeder



Rotarian Yolanda Archuletta addressed the club at our past meeting as executive director of Habitat for Humanity. Yolanda presented to the club a new program that will be launching a new neighborhood revitalization initiative. This new program is designed to reduce substandard housing conditions, improve safety and security in our neighborhoods. Wicklow Heights will be the first neighbor to receive assistance through the program. Wicklow Heights is located near Hampton Avenue. Habitat plans to invest

\$145,000 in fiscal year 2019-2020, \$250,000 in fiscal year 2020-2021 and \$335,000 in fiscal year 2021-2022. Yolanda went on to say that they plan to partner with other organizations and volunteers. Giving the community an fantastic avenue to get involved, through one-day project the cost as a team building exercise. The cost for a group will be \$50.00 The Neighborhood Revitalization initiative will not supplant our Homeowner Program. We will continue to build new homes in Aiken County for qualified applicants.
