Thank you for your interest in the Rotary Club of Clemson Foundation 2022 Community Service Grant Program. Our organization is comprised of local professionals and retirees who work together to improve our communities in which we live and assist people around the world through our motto, "Service Above Self". The goal is to work with our community partners to insure we aide our community in a meaningful way.

The Rotary Club of Clemson Foundation Community Service Grant Program is modeled after Rotary International's Foundation. The Grant Program, like the International Foundation, bases its grants on six areas of focus which are used to support our peace efforts and end polio forever. Those six areas of focus are Promoting Peace, Providing Clean Water, Saving Mothers and Children, Supporting Education, Growing Local Economies and Fighting Disease. Each year the Rotary Club of Clemson Foundation Board selects funding applications from local organizations and or projects that work within our community to better these areas of people's lives.

Candidates for the Community Service Grant must fulfill the following criteria:

- Understand that monies applied for must be used to serve communities in Pickens, Oconee and Anderson counties
- State a clear purpose/mission for monies applied for to help our community. Monies must be for organizational programs, not operating/overhead expenses. (Examples: rent, water, electricity)
- Organization must be registered with the state as a non-profit organization
- Project or organization must meet the standards of Rotary's Four-Way Test: Is it the truth? Is it fair to all concerned? Does it build goodwill and better friendships? Will it be beneficial to all concerned?
- Project or organization must meet at least ONE of the Rotary International Foundation's six focus areas: Promoting Peace, Providing Clean Water, Saving Mothers and Children, Supporting Education, Growing Local Economies and Fighting Disease
- If a previous recipient of monies, an Impact Report must be completed and submitted with 2020 application.
