Rotarians volunteer in various school programs and we provide resources for professional development for teachers in the area of literacy. Each year we distribute a dictionary to every third grader in the Daniel Island and Cainhoy Elementary Schools.

#### **COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS:** Annually.

we award competitive scholarships to local area high school students to be used toward their freshman year of college. In the spring of 2009, we awarded four scholarships totaling \$8,000. We also provided additional stipends to previous winners toward their second year of college.
