SOUNDWAVES PERFORMERS SAFETY GUIDELINES
EFFECTIVE APRIL 30, 2020 UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE**

The Hilton Head Symphony Orchestra desires to maintain contact with its patrons and the greater community during the current COVID-19 Pandemic. In consultation with the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control, the following guidelines have been established to ensure the safety of performers and production personnel during live-streamed events.

1. SoundWaves and the HHSO administrative offices will remain closed to the public, and only authorized personnel will be permitted to enter. Gloves, masks, and sanitary wipes will be made available and good handwashing techniques will be utilized by everyone.
2. Production personnel will wear masks.
3. Physical distancing of 6' will be observed at all times, including within performance set-ups and during set-ups and breakdowns.
4. All spaces, including common spaces, such as "green rooms" and rest rooms, will be cleaned and sterilized before and after each event using cleaning products that meet the EPA's criteria for use against SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19.
5. Doors will either be held open with door stops or lock mechanisms will be disengaged so that doors can be opened without using knobs or handles.
6. Equipment used by more than one individual will be sanitized between users.
