I. Overview of Scholarships:

- A. The Rotary Club of Danbury One Year Scholarship provides a one time award of \$5,000 for an incoming student attending Western Connecticut State University.
- B. The Richmond C. Hubbard Scholarship provides a one time award of \$2,000.
- C. The Ives Bank Scholarship provides a one time award of \$2,500 for students attending Western Connecticut State University.
- D. The Union Savings Bank Scholarships provides two (2), \$2,500 awards for students attending Western Connecticut State University.
- E. 2025 Rotary Club Of Danbury Technical School Scholarship provides a one time award of \$2,000 to a student at Henry Abbott Technical High School.
- F. The Rotary Club of Danbury will award two (2) unrestricted scholarships to students who have demonstrated their commitment to community service

II. Recipients to have the following qualifications:

- A. A high school senior in good standing at one of the following schools:
 - 1. Danbury High School
 - 2. New Fairfield High School
 - 3. Bethel High School
 - 4. Henry Abbott Regional High School
 - 5. Immaculate High School
 - 6. Brookfield High School
- B. Upper third of graduating class
- C. Needs financial assistance. (A student who is receiving any other financial aid will disclose in writing the amount and the source).
- D. Must be a U.S. citizen or a legal alien, or in the process of applying for same (proof of application required).
- E. For those attending WCSU, must join Rotaract, a Rotary Club community service club at WCSU and be an active member.

III. To apply for any of the scholarships, the student must submit the following:

- A. A copy of his/her Western Connecticut State University undergraduate admission letter (where necessary)
- B. A copy of his/her completed full FASFA form, including financial information.
- C. A copy of his/her high school transcripts.
- D. A letter of recommendation from a high school staff member.
- E. A completed Rotary Club of Danbury Scholarship application form.

Note: The Scholarship Committee will examine the application and certification of all applicants and review the finalists.

The funds will be paid directly to Western Connecticut State University or the recipient as the Scholarship Committee deems appropriate.
