2025 Eduard Baruch Memorial Scholarship 2025 Robert Vetter and Family Scholarship

I. Provisions

- Provide two (2), \$2,000 scholarships for two undergraduate students attending Western Connecticut State University, who have completed at least one academic year as a fulltime student and who will be enrolled at Western Connecticut State University the following year.
- The funds will be paid directly to the institution or to the recipient, as the Scholarship Committee deems appropriate.
- The Robert Vetter and Family Scholarship is unrestricted. The Eduard Baruch Scholarship is available to students enrolled in the Ancell School of Business

Must be a U.S citizen or Legal Resident / Immigrant

Must join Rotaract, a Rotary Club community service club at WCSU.

II. Recipients to have the following qualifications:

- A. Excellent academic ability, good character, and must show certifiable financial need.
- B. The recommendation of Chairperson of the department in which applicant is earning his/her major.
- C. The Robert Vetter and Family Scholarship is open to any Western Connecticut State University student having completed one year at Western Connecticut State University.
- D. The Eduard Baruch Scholarship is open to any student starting his/her junior or senior year enrolled in the Ancell School of Business.

III. To apply, the student must submit the following:

- A. A copy of his/her completed financial aid form.
- B. A letter of recommendation from a WCSU staff member.
- C. A copy of latest transcript.
- D. A completed Rotary Club of Danbury Scholarship application form.

Note: The Scholarship Committee will examine the application and certification of all applicants and will interview the finalists.
