Thomas Jefferson wrote the Declaration of Independence, he established the University of Virginia, attempted to bring our Naïve Americans into our society, championed public education believing education should be for all and not just the priveleged few, and was a champion of not only freedom of

religion but the right to have ideas contrary to the government. He insisted that the people were the government—not vice versa. All public officials were accountable to the people and no man was above the



law or completely in charge. He was as much our founding father as was George Washington.

Dr. Gutzman has both a JD and PhD, is the best selling author of 4 books including a history of James Madison, and is Chairman of the Department of History at Western Connecticut State University. He lives with his son in Bethel, Connecticut
