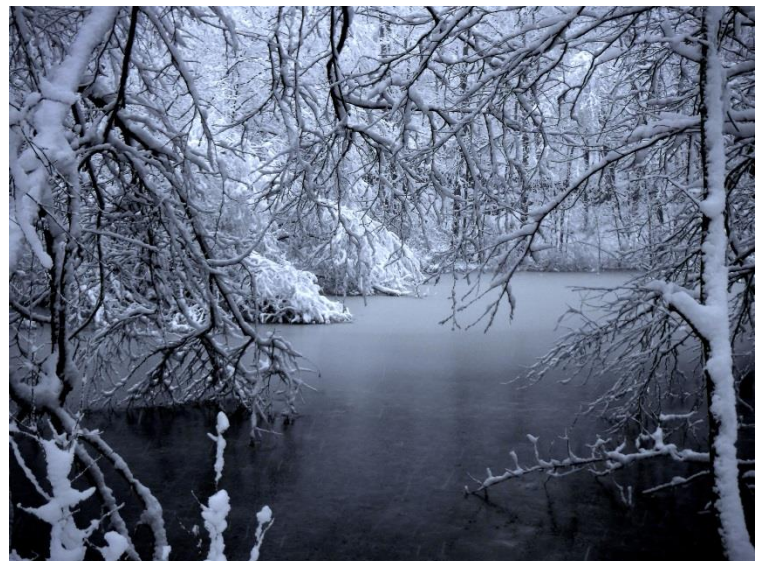
Another Nor'Easter, and Another Luncheon Cancelled:
