The Paul Harris Fellow award was established by Rotary International in 1957 to recognize either those individuals, or clubs who had wished to honor someone with a \$1,000 gift to the Rotary Foundation. I feel a small sense of chagrin knowing I now possess nearly as many pins as had been given out to club member in all of the previous years when I was club president for the 1982-83 Rotary year (eight—only 10 fellows had been honored in all of the prior years of our club, and John Lucchesi was one of them). The medallion was not available until 1969. By 2006, the number of Fellows reached one million, including Mother Theresa, astronaut James Lovell, Pearl Bailey, and Jimmy Carter. Receiving my 8th pin did not diminish my feelings about the value of the award at all. Being recognized for one's efforts is always humbling and deeply appreciated , but the donation to the Foundation is far more important.
