A Prominent July Birthday--Princess Diana: Born July 1, 1961: Died August 31, 1997--

August 31, 1997 Jane and I were in a plane heading for London when the pilot came on the intercom and told us of the death of Diana, Prince of Wales. The following week was surreal, as the flowers and tributes piled up head high around Harrods and Buckingham Palace. We watched



the funeral with thousands of grieving Londoners on several jumbo-tron screens set up in Central Park before leaving town. Di's favorite quote of mine is truly in the spirit of Rotary: "Carry out a random act of kindness with no expectation of reward, safe in the knowledge that one day someone might do the same for you." We rarely find ourselves in the middle of historical events, but this was surely one of them.
