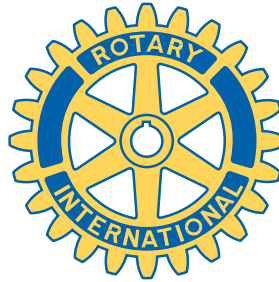
SERVICE ABOVE SELF

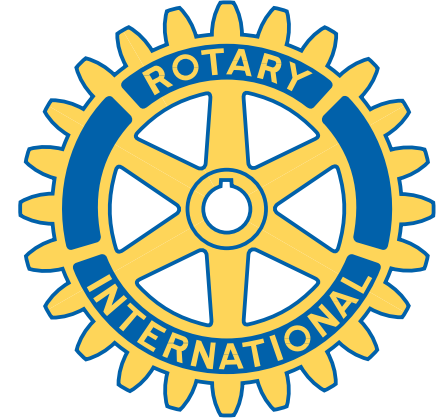

BENEFITS OF JOINING FRIENDS

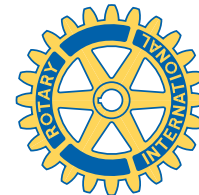
The overriding benefit is that as a humanitarian, you are making a contribution to the community you have a vested interest in through Rotary, one of the most respected service organizations in the world.
