#### **Speaker description:**

Uganda Farmers Inc. (UFI) was established 13 years ago by Milford residents and attorneys Jane Holler and Dan Marecki. To date, they have built 9 wells in Uganda and Tanzania, including infrastructure and electricity systems (typically solar plants). In a country stepped in poverty, UFI steps in to provide critical needs to East Africa's citizens, who are very often ignored by the governments for political reasons. Running water is important because it means people won't have to spend the majority of their day fetching water and sterilizing it, meaning they have more time to be educated, work, and build infrastructure, thus increasing their self-dependence.
