Speaker description:

Ben Blake has been the mayor of Milford, CT since 2011. He is running for the upcoming mayoral election in November. During his term he increased the city's reserve fund from \$17m to \$42m and bumped the city to a AAA bond rating. Ben says the economic indicators such as job growth are very good, and taxes are the same or lower than previous years. With 17.5 miles of coast, a big issue with the federal government is the disagreements with DEEP, who want Milford to retreat from the coast instead of building up erosion/flood defenses. Ben also elaborated on the pension situation in Milford, saying that city pensions are now based on base pay so employees can't load up on overtime to substantially increase their pensions when they retire, which would put the city into economic peril.
