Speaker description: Dr. Tom Margias, Optometrist, joining us here because the Tour De France was cancelled this year. He told us about eye twitches, floaters, and other various eye conditions. There are different layers to the exterior of the cornea: the mucus layer, aqueous layer, and lipid layer. Everyone has cataracts, but over time they cloud and turn yellow. They can be prevented with a good diet, avoiding UV exposure, and controlling medical conditions such as diabetes with insulin. Macular degeneration reduces field of view from a blood leakage in the eye. It used to never be treatable, but recently it was discovered that a certain injection could mostly fix it.
