Kyle Akin is the President and co-founder of Fireside Distillers (Fireside). Fireside began as a collaboration between Akin, a USMC veteran/Civil Engineer/entrepreneur with a dream and energy, and his former boss/mentor who believed in that dream (and Kyle's energy).

Fireside started in 2013 and released their first brand, Crescendo, in 2014. Their second brand, Diamond Clear, was released in 2022. Crescendo and Diamond Clear are both organic spirit brands that are sold in Oregon, Washington and Montana liquor stores.

Fireside is a small business with less than 5 employees/contractors. All production byproducts are donated to local nonprofits and farms so

they have almost no waste. "Our organic certification shows our commitment to transparency, and accountability for our production process and end products."

Fireside's Eugene tasting room features their "signature spiritsâ€. These are their limited release handmade whiskey, rum, gin, and brandy products along with whatever else they decide to make. Fireside is a veteran-owned and operated business located at 4065 W. 11th Ave #47 in Eugene, Oregon. Give them a visit!


