July 9th Meeting: The Eugene Rotary Scholarship Foundation



The Eugene Rotary Scholarship Foundation (ERSF) was incorporated on June 13, 1956. Each member of the Rotary Club of Eugene is a voting member of the ERSF corporation. The Bylaws of the ERSF state that the annual meeting of the Foundation shall be held on the second Tuesday of July. President of the ERSF Board of Trustees (Board) Scott Palmer will lead the 69th annual meeting of the Foundation this Tuesday.

The Agenda of the meeting will consist of an election to vote for two new members of the Board. Board members are elected for a term of three years and may run for an additional two three-year terms. Trustees Scott Palmer and Ed Barclay are leaving the Board after serving nine consecutive years on the Board. There are two Club members standing for election to fill their seats on the Board: Chris Binstadt and Liz Ness.



Chris is one of our newest members, joining in June 2024. He is currently co-volunteer coordinator for our Food for Lane County (FFLC) food rescue team. Chris is a self-employed technology consultant. Liz is a past-president of the Club and a financial advisor at Stifel. She has been with the Club since January 2018. In addition to these two candidates, nominations for additional candidates may be made from the floor.

After the election, a report from the Board stating the health of the corporation will be presented to the membership. Upon completion of the report, Board President Scott will take the lead in awarding ERSF scholarships to our six 2024 scholars.

In addition to the scholarship awards, and through the efforts of club member Mike Grudzien (also a NexStep Recycling board member) and Jessica Ahrenholtz, the executive director of NextStep, our scholars have been awarded fully rebuilt laptop computers from NextStep. Jessica will

present the laptops to our scholars. This is the fourth year of the ERSF's collaboration with NextStep to ensure our scholars will begin their college careers well-equipped to succeed.

Please plan on attending this Tuesday to participate in these important ERSF tasks and to celebrate our six awardees. They are richly deserving of their awards.

Please take a minute to personally thank Ed and Scott for their exemplary contribution of their time and principled guidance of the ERSF for nine years.
