2008 the groundbreaking show Breaking Bad premiered on AMC.

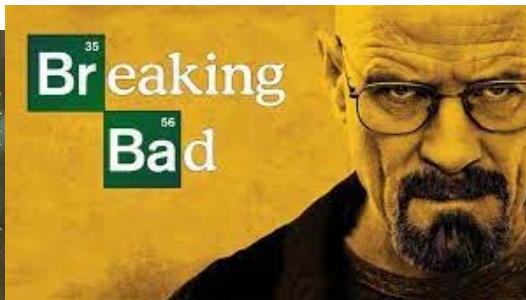
1982 Ozzy Osbourne bit the head of a bat at his concert.
