Executive Director Kathleen Miller joined us from Living Grace Homes. Living Grace was founded in 2007 to rescue homeless moms 18-24 years of age. The demographic they serve have been traumatized coming from various

difficult situations. Only 30% have graduated from high school. Many have criminal records. 90% of their residents choose to raise their babies



and Living Grace provides parenting, financial literacy training and more. The organization is faith based and they promote Christian principles. They can currently support 8 in their pregnancy residency and 4 moms plus child(ren) in the parenting facility. Their focus is on education and transition to independent living.

Kathleen thanked **PP Mike Peterson** who raised funds for Living Grace at his Kentucky Derby race at his home.
