New members Grant Fujiwara and Jason Ramos were given their Paul Harris Fellow award certificates and longtime members Gilda Moshir and Dennis Kneier were recognized for reaching another level of Paul Harris giving. All the money given goes to the Rotary Foundation, which is one of the world's premier foundations in terms of size, scope of work and efficiency of administration. It is a "4 star charity", which is the Charity Navigator's highest level. In the 2021-2022 Grant Year, \$27 million was awarded for 478 district grants, \$8 million was given for 207 disaster response grants, and \$73 million spent on 1,199 global grants. It's clear that the Rotary Foundation "makes a difference."
