MAY 22 PROGRAM: PEPPY SCIARRA, WWII VET

Joe "Peppy" Sciarra is a World War II Veteran who entered the Army just after high school graduation and was assigned to a 81mm mortar squad in General MacArthur's army. After 9 months of training in New Caledonia, he and 68,000 other soldiers landed at Luzon in the Philippines and endured five and a half months of terrible jungle fighting, capturing 47 different ridges from 100,000 defending Japanese. Following the Japanese surrender, Peppy was assigned as part of the mainland Japan occupation forces. Sciarra suffered from the effects of malaria for a long time after returning home and faced numerous challenges securing his veteran benefits because many of the records had been destroyed. Peppy wants people to know what our guys went through during the war and, even after 80 years, he still thinks about all the men in his platoon who didn't make it back. Now 100 years old, Peppy lives in Arcadia and is a member of the Alhambra-Monterey Park Rotary Club. Thanks to Bill Payne for bringing us this special Memorial Day program.
