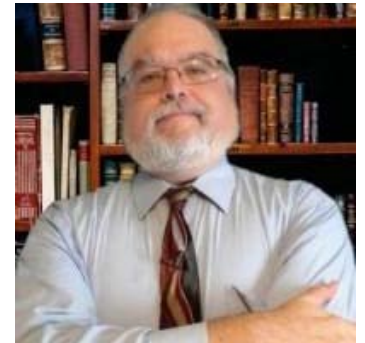

He has several published articles in peer-reviewed journals, including the Journal of Clinical Oncology, BMJ, Federal Practitioner, and Cureus. Dr. Manthri accomplished award-winning presentations on unique clinical findings in regional and national conferences including Appalachian Student Research Forum, Southern Society of Clinical Investigation Annual Meeting, American College of Physician State chapter annual meeting, American Medical Association annual meeting and Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center 2nd International Symposium.

Dr. Manthri received his medical degree from the Prathima Institute of Medical Sciences in India. He completed a clinical research fellowship in Cleveland Clinic Florida followed by an internal medicine residency at Southern Illinois University in Springfield, IL. Subsequently, he completed his hospice and palliative medicine fellowship at Saint Louis University, St. Louis, MO. Dr. Manthri, completed his oncology fellowship at East Tennessee State University, Johnson City, TN. During his fellowship training, he was honored with the designation of chief medical oncology fellow for the year 2019-2020.
