In helping to develop Character Education, the program reinforces the concepts taught through the PATH Program by second-grade teachers and school counselors. Usually meeting weekly, Rotary volunteers with the aid of high school helpers teach six broad concepts through 25 lessons in areas such as Self-Awareness, Personal Responsibility and Relationship Skills. Each lesson consists of a book which presented to the students and an activity and lasts about 30 minutes.

Message from the Westerville Sunrise Rotary Board- Fee Increase

Quarterly Fees Increase Announcement

Dear Sunrise Rotarians,
Your Westerville Sunrise Rotary Club Board ("Club Board") approves an operating budget annually for the club that includes expenses for meeting space and meals, technology, social events and Rotary meetings/conferences. Quarterly dues from each Rotarian offset these expenses. At its July 2022 meeting your Club Board approved the 2022-2023 operating budget and voted to increase quarterly fees starting in this fiscal year as follows:

Quarter 1: fees remain \$75 (already billed)

Quarter 2: increase to \$85

Quarter 3: increase to \$90

Quarter 4: increase to \$95

Your Club Board members reviewed this decision carefully as we all know that current economic conditions are bringing increased costs to almost everything and it is important to have a balanced budget. There are several factors your board cited as a basis for making this change.
1. Our club has lost members which reduces revenue to the operating budget. Our current

membership is listed as 117, which is down from a peak of over 130.

2. The approved operating budget included expense reductions such as cuts to the Make a Difference program and Leadership Westerville.
3. The club has not raised quarterly fees since 2016.
4. Our total cost of membership is still one of the lowest in the district.
5. We anticipate increases in both District and Rotary International Membership Dues in the near future and this fee increase takes into account those anticipated increases for the near future.

Your Club Board members remain committed to being transparent about the operating budgets and the decision to increase the quarterly fees. Please feel free to reach out to any of us if you have questions about this change.
