WildLights at the Zoo!

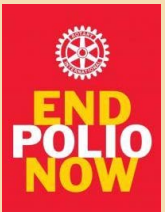

Water Within Reach

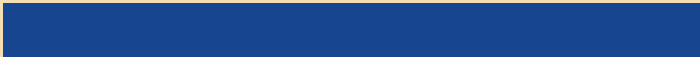

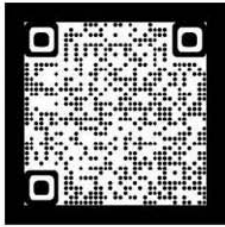
