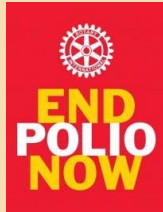
Hello Sunrise Rotarians and John Conley,



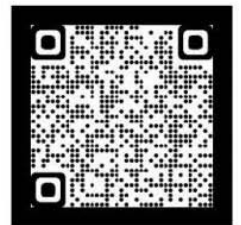
