There will be a brief intro, so please provide Rotarians names and then we have our student council saying a few words as well. I hope the pole presentation will be around 10 min.



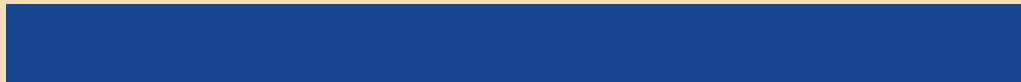
