## Can't Miss Program

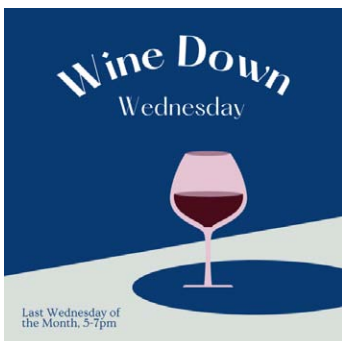
You don't want to miss **Steve Stivers** on Tuesday at The Boat House!

## Newark Rotary to host Be Our Guest District Conference April 25-26

Great speakers, informative breakout sessions plus loads of fun are in store for Rotarians who plan to attend the District 6690 Conference April 25-26 at the Cherry Valley Hotel, Newark.

**John Germ, Rotary International President 2016-2017** will kick off the event that starts Friday evening with a Rotary Foundation Gala dinner at 5 p.m. The Peter Larson Quartet will provide entertainment. Peter is a member of the Newark Rotary Club and has performed with such notable artists as Dionne Warwick.

Saturday's session starts with keynote speaker **Jason Browne**, a Rotarian and motivational speaker who has collaborated with Microsoft, Facebook and Rotary International. **Jenny Stotts**, Assistant Membership Chair for Zone 30-31, will talk about "Take Action Around Mental Health" during her keynote address after lunch. Professionally, Jenny was appointed by Governor Mike DeWine to serve as Ohio's first Youth Ombudsman. As Ohio's Youth Ombudsman, she leads a staff who investigates and resolves complaints and concerns submitted by foster youth, including suspected violations of Ohio's foster youth bill of rights.

Attendees can choose to attend two breakout sessions, including a presentation by **Columbus Rotarian Dr. Terry Davis** on the Rafiki School and Orphanage. During Saturday afternoon, Rotarians will pack Hope Boxes for patients undergoing cancer treatment. The conference concludes with a dinner and a Parade of Rotary Club Presidents. Following dinner, comedian and ventriloquist Al Getler will perform.
