## PROGRAM

**District Governor Gary Baker** introduced today's guest, Past President **Jim Young**. **Jim Young** trekked to Mt. Everest Base Camp in April. **Jim** has had numerous adventures all over the globe, and those have taken him to all 7 continents and all 50 states. The motivation for hiking to Everest Base Camp was just like the motivation for many of his other adventures: it was a bucket list item.

**Jim** prepared for four months, training for this trip. Getting there was over 19 hours of flights. The hike was 40 miles up, over nine days, to reach base camp, with an altitude of over 17,500 feet. **Jim** was a group of one, hiking with one sherpa and one porter. He shared pictures of the beautiful scenery, climbing high in the Himalayas. He spent one night in the home of locals, but otherwise spent his nights in "tea rooms" with no heat, and typically no shower. He left a prayer flag at Base Camp with the hope that some future generation will see it in person.
