John Savona was named Plant Manager of Ford's Louisville Assembly Plant in January 2011. John has enjoyed a 22-year career at Ford. From 2004 to 2008, John served as the Plant Manager at the Michigan Truck plant. From 2008 to 2011, he was in charge of Auto Alliance International, which is a Ford and Mazda joint venture.

Ford is investing \$600 million in the Louisville Assembly Plant, which will make LAP one of Ford's most flexible and technologically advanced plants in the world. The plant will soon begin production of the all new Ford Escape and will share a platform with the next generation Ford Kuga. This investment will bring an estimated 3100 new jobs to our community.

John has bachelor's degrees from Eastern Michigan University and the University of Michigan and an MBA from Central Michigan University. He currently serves on the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation Board and has volunteered for the March of Dimes, Relay for Life, Knights of Columbus, Home of the Innocents, The Boys and Girls Clubs, and many other community organizations.

It was an all-Rotary show when Allan Parnell gave the invocation, Gordon Costley led the Pledge and Gordon, Charlie Castner, Jim Baker and Bob Slider presented a twangy version of "Money." Connie Cheak introduced birthday celebrants and President Stet saluted membership anniversaries of Brent Girdler, 5 years; John Hodgin, 20; and Michael Ehrler, 45.

Stet reminded 85-rule members they still have to pay for lunch, which will increase for everyone to \$20, including tax and service charge, on January 26. Lee Squires drew Heather Whelan's name to receive a free booth at the March 1 Rotary Trade Expo (registration deadline is February 20).

Susan Barry presented a \$10,000 L.L. Anderson (our first prez) award from the Louisville Community Foundation to our Rotary Foundation for the Rotary Promise Scholarship Challenge, and she raised a toast to the memory of Baylor Landrum, Jr., who made the gift and our Rotary Leadership Fellows program possible.



Robert 'Bob' Bordogna, Bosworth 'Bos' Todd, Jr. and President Maynard 'Stet' L. Stetten, M.D.

Bob Bordogna introduced Bosworth Todd for his annual economic forecast. The "Wizard of Bos" averaged 11.3% with last year's five picks, even though "the AFLAC duck didn't fly," compared with 2.3% for the S&P, which put his portfolio in the top one percent of all foreign and domestic investment categories.

Bos said, "the best investments may be stocks that are large, boring and often out of favor, but ideal in this uncertain time." His 2012 picks: Microsoft (MSFP) at \$28 per share, with a 3% dividend and \$23 Billion profits on \$70 Billion revenues. And four carryovers: McDonalds (MCD) \$100; Philip Morris (PM) \$73; Coca-Cola (KO) \$63 and Vodaphone (VOD) \$27.
