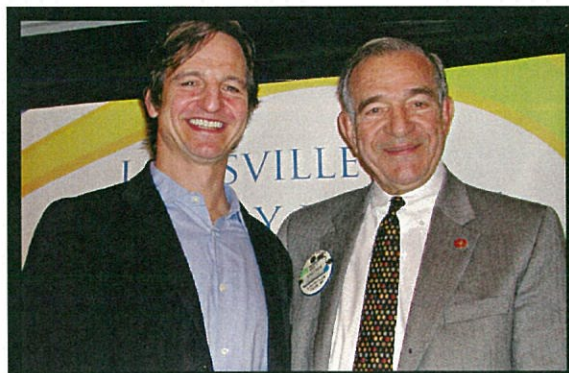


## Club Meeting - December 15, 2011

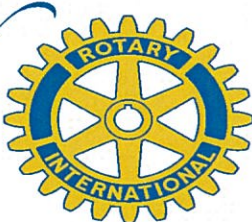


### IN MEMORY OF ROTARIAN JOHN H. McBRIDE

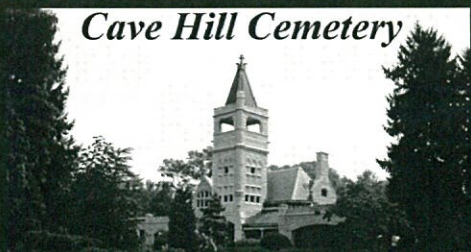

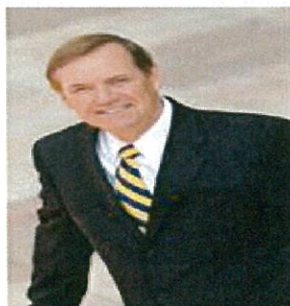
