About Tim Allen:

Timothy Joseph Allen is an American figurative painter who has been living and working in Rome, Italy for over 20 years. He began his career in 1992, earning a BA in Studio Art at DePauw University and an MFA in Painting at Indiana University, Bloomington in 1998. He has been teaching at The American University of Rome since 2006 and has managed his own painting school, the Painting and Drawing Art Studio of Rome, since 2010.

August 15th Meeting Recap:

Vince Tyra, Athletic Director for the University of Louisville, expressed to Rotarians a commitment to integrity, he has emphasized throughout the U of L Athletic Department and athletes since taking the A.D. position in March, 2018. "When I was a kid," he related, "At the bottom of the report card was 'effort' and 'conduct,' and both of those were expected to be 'O' for outstanding. We expect that of the students on and off the field, and we've set that tone in the office. When you do that, you start making the right decisions, and I have to set that example." Vince shared the Core Beliefs he is promoting through U of L athletics: we choose integrity first; we develop our student athletes; we win together; we all work in customer service; we always seek to improve; we share the organizational playbook; and we are fans too. Vince compared his responsibilities as A.D. to his own athletic experience, saying that as a bull pin pitcher, if you come into the game with the bases loaded, you don't care how the players got on base. You have to focus on the batter at the plate. Vince's focus on ethics was clear to Rotarians, and particularly evident in his concern about dedication to well-rounded athletes.




