About Congressman Yarmuth:

Congressman John Yarmuth represents Kentucky's 3rd Congressional District in the U.S. House of Representatives. Now in his seventh term, he was elected Chairman of the House Budget Committee for the 116th Congress. He has been recognized for his work to improve education, expand access to affordable health care, and revitalize manufacturing in Louisville.

Born and raised in Louisville, Kentucky, Congressman Yarmuth graduated from Atherton High School and Yale University. He and his wife, Cathy, have one son, Aaron, who is owner and editor of LEO Weekly.



August 22nd Meeting Recap:

Professor Timothy Allen, returning to his hometown of Louisville from the American University of Rome, provided a provocative and engaging demonstration of "Formal Analysis" to identify the figure of Matthew in Caravaggio's painting, The Calling of St. Matthew. As Professor Allen explained about the enigmatic painting completed for the Contarelli Chapel in Rome, 1599-1600, Caravaggio characteristically provides many deceptive gestures and treatments of light and shadow to make St. Matthew's identity unclear in the painting. Also at the time, Allen's process provided suspense and tension that needed to be resolved. He methodically pointed to several uses of composition, lighting and symbolism to reveal St. Matthew to be the central figure in the painting, while cogently making the broader point that many perspectives, and multiple approaches to analysis may be needed to pursue the truth, particularly when dealing with "Caravaggio and the art of subversion."
