KY HONOR FLIGHT - Wednesday, October 20, 2021



This is the first (and perhaps only) 2021 Honor Flight for Kentucky and Southern Indiana area veterans of WWII, Korea and Vietnam.

Several Rotary club members regularly volunteer in the Ground Crew for these flights under the direction of Bill Brundage, owner of Brundage Jewelers. Crew members greet and assist the arriving veterans and their families to check in between 5 am to 6 am. Donuts, bottled water and coffee are offered before they board the chartered

airliner for a departure around 7 am.

Upon arrival in Washington DC, charter buses with police escorts take them to visit the various war memorials and the Arlington Cemetery. This includes stops for lunch and group meetings with some of our elected officials. They return on the same charter flight in early evening, usually arriving back to the Louisville Ali airport between 9pm and 10 pm.

Ground crew volunteers are waiting upon their arrival to assist the vets as they deplane and to escort them through the airport. Then they are reunited with their families and friends who line the corridor on the west end of the second floor of the terminal to cheer and thank them for their service. There are usually several hundred people there, including many veterans, patriotic singers and bagpipers joining in the reception to welcome them home. It is a very emotional experience for the vets, their families, well-wishers and all of the volunteers who assist the vets in checking out and departing for home.

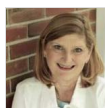
