**About Dr. Wayne B. Tuckson**

Wayne B. Tuckson, M.D. is a colorectal surgeon practicing in Louisville. He is a graduate of Howard University Medical School in Washington, D.C., with postgraduate training at St. Louis University Hospital, Howard University Hospital and the Cleveland Clinic. After serving as chief of the Division of Colon and Rectal Surgery at Howard University, he joined the faculty of the University of Louisville Dept. of Surgery in 1994. Dr. Tuckson left the university in 2001 to start Kentuckiana Colon and Rectal Surgery.

In addition to his private practice, Dr. Tuckson is deeply committed to the health of our community. He reaches out to Kentucky and Louisville residents via Kentucky Health, the KET television show he developed and hosts. Kentucky Health has received several national awards for excellence of content during its 15 years of broadcast and is a weekly a resource for families across our Commonwealth.

# ROTARY MEETING RECAP:

## Kent Oyler - January 31st, 2019

Much in-line with his Business First guest commentary published Dec. 18 last year, Kent Oyler, President and CEO of Greater Louisville, Inc., delivered a direct address regarding Louisville's opportunities for growth. Mr. Oyler commented that while Louisville is enjoying many areas of growth and progress, such as low unemployment and tourism growth, we have not followed the recommendations of the 1996 Boyle Report, and have fallen behind the growth of our peer cities, such as Austin, Nashville, Charlotte, Raleigh and Columbus. "From 2010 through 2017 compared to 15 peer cities, Louisville ranks seventh in job growth, eighth in labor force growth, 11th in population growth, 12th in wage growth and 14th in college degree growth", Kent said in his Dec. 18 commentary and to Rotarians. "Forty to fifty percent of our jobs are at risk of elimination due to automation," he said, speaking to Louisville's need for technological advancement. As for solutions, Mr. Oyler specified we need to attract more young talent (like Denver), emphasize more tech skills in education, and assimilate greater "topophilia", love of place, by daring to boldly claim more of the greatness we do have.

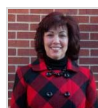

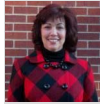
