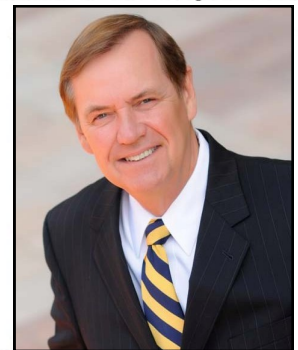

All Rotarians who bring a prospective member will receive two free drink tickets. Our co-host is YPAL.

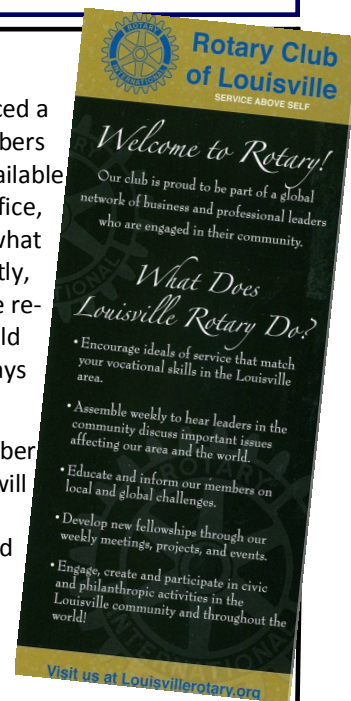
MEAT is on the 2nd floor above The Blind Pig. Go to the rear and up the stairs.
