Dick Brien, Director of Training for Dale Carnegie Training at Sullivan University, provided the ideal speech, "Enhancing Relationships," for our Valentine's Day meeting. Dick expertly presented his high points of the Dale Carnegie principles for becoming a friendlier person:

1. Don't criticize, condemn or complain.
2. Give honest, sincere appreciation.
3. Arouse in the other person an eager want.
4. Smile!
5. Remember a person's name.
6. Be a good listener.
7. Talk in terms of the other person's interests.
8. Make the other person feel important.

Dick added, "The best listeners in the world are the best questioners in the world." He emphasized that being focused on the needs and interests of others provides the greatest fulfillment in relationships and life.


