About Mayor Greg Fischer:

Mayor Greg Fischer was elected in 2010 and was sworn in for a third four-year term on January 5, 2019. During Mayor Fischer's tenure, Louisville has experienced a renaissance, adding 83,000 jobs and 3,000 new businesses, with unprecedented investments in affordable housing. In addition, 37,000 Louisvillians have worked themselves out of poverty or into the middle class. More than \$15 billion dollars in capital construction is planned or underway, including 25 new hotels built to support the city's thriving bourbon and local food tourism, also known as Bourbonism. Louisville has been named an International Model City of Compassion four times and a Top 15 city for attracting millennials.

January 30th Meeting Recap:

At this week's meeting, Robert Fleming, Executive Artistic Director of the Actors Theatre of Louisville provided Rotarians with a lively conversation about the multidimensional intersection of theatre and social enterprise, agile business practices, and community building. Robert began his presentation by addressing the organizational restructuring that happened within the Actors Theatre earlier in the week. He then discussed his childhood and the decisions and influences that led him to the arts. Robert's passion for the arts stems from his belief that the theatre has a responsibility to "engage the audience in a conversation that moves them to action which will lead to a meaningful impact on our community." Robert engaged Rotarians in a comparison of the two versions of *The Little Mermaid*, one by Disney and the other by Hans Christian Anderson, to show the difference in interpretations and the idea that narratives are how we understand ourselves. Robert ended his presentation by stating, "Trauma is inevitable and something we share. How do we navigate that? He believes that the arts can give each of us a voice and place to share our commonalities and bring our community together.
