Parlympian and Polio Survivor

Topic: Surviving Polio and Becoming a U.S. Paralympian

Dennis Ogbe is a United States Paralympian. Dennis represented the United States in London at the 2012 Paralympic Games and holds the United States record in Shot-Put and Discus (Class F58). Prior to the 2012 Paralympic Games Dennis competed in the Para-Pan American Games in Mexico and won a Silver Medal in Discus F58. At the 2011 World Championship Games in Christchurch, New Zealand and was selected by his teammates to be the flag-bearer for Team USA at the Opening Ceremonies. Dennis began his journey to the Paralympic Games in his native country of Nigeria and continued as a student at Bellarmine University in Louisville, Kentucky.

Dennis' journey was noted in the HBO documentary and book Citizen USA: A 50 State Road Trip by Alexandra Pelosi, Time Magazine, CNN Online, The Miami Herald, The Courier-Journal and National Public Radio (NPR). In addition to his athletic and academic accomplishments Dennis is employed by Brown-Forman Corp. and is a Global Advocate for the eradication of Polio through the United Nations Foundation Shot@Life and Rotary International. Dennis, his wife and two kids live in Prospect, Kentucky.
