Our January 18th Rotary Club meeting featured **Donald E. Lassere**, President and CEO of the Muhammad Ali Center. Donald began his presentation titled, "The Ali in All of Us," by comparing the Rotary Club's mission for "Service Above Self" to the mission of the Muhammad Ali Center. He told Rotarians that while some saw Ali as controversial, his actions showed that he loved everyone. Ali stood up for his convictions in a time when our country was deeply divided. Today, the Muhammad Ali Center uses Ali's examples to teach young people that they can overcome adversity to achieve greatness by using six core principles: Confidence, Conviction,

Dedication, Giving, Respect and Spirituality. Donald ended his discussion by challenging Rotarians to think about their own set of principles. He also gave some updates on the center as far as renovations and programs that are offered and encouraged everyone to visit the Muhammad Ali Center.
