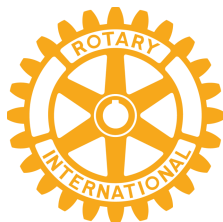

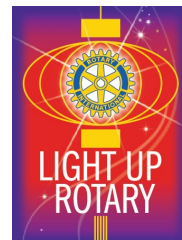

Bill Goodman is the host and managing editor of the Emmy-Award winning public affairs series *Kentucky Tonight* on KET (Kentucky Educational Television). Additionally, he serves as host for *Education Matters*, KET's election night coverage, and *One to One with Bill Goodman*, where he has conducted compelling conversations with guests including Pulitzer Prize winner George Will; actor Richard Dreyfuss; current and former Kentucky political leaders; and many others. In April 2013, Bill was inducted into the Kentucky Journalism Hall of Fame.

A native of Glasgow, Ky., Bill graduated from Western Kentucky University and holds an MFA in Creative Nonfiction from Spalding University. Prior to coming to KET, Bill worked at TV stations in Nashville and Houston.

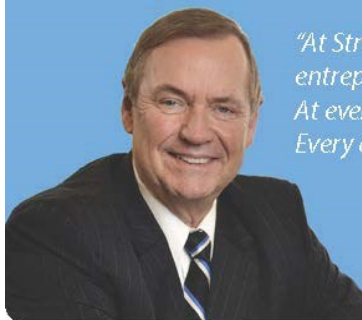
