

Kevin Connelly is the founding director for the Center for Nonprofit Excellence (CNPE). CNPE is a not-forprofit support center that offers training and consultation for nonprofit organizations that was launched by the Donors Forum, Metro United Way and City of Louisville in 1999. Prior to this position, he was executive director for YMCA Safe Place Services, home of the National Safe Program at that time. He served as Chair of the Southeastern Network for Youth and Family Services and a two-term position on the Council on Youth Policy in Washington, DC.

Kevin earned his master's degree in psychology and psychometrics from Spalding University and BA degree in psychology from Brescia University. In addition to his work with the Center for Nonprofit Excellence, he was adjunct professor with the University of Louisville, School of Urban and Public Affairs for the past ten years.






## **Rotary Bikers**

### July 24, 2014 Rotary Meeting

The Rotary Club of Louisville convened on Thursday, July 24, 2014 at The Galt House. The meeting was called to order by Club President Kevin Wardell. The invocation was given by Alice Bridges. Barbara Collins, President of Kitchen Planning Designs, led the Club in the pledge of allegiance, and also introduced soloist Robert Adelberg and pianist Mary Means.

President Kevin informed the members that in honor of the Club's 102<sup>nd</sup> birthday, several historical photos were on display today and will be on display at next week's meeting. Kristin Willard, Senior Vice President of Sales at Voluforms, introduced the birthday table and the honorees who were present were honored with the singing of Happy Birthday. Several Club members introduced their guests. Laura Crahan, Leadership Fellow, was also recognized upon her return from France where she had the opportunity to visit the Rotary Club Sete. President Kevin provided all members with an

overview of the Club's Strategic Plan for 2014–2015. The Plan includes five Strategic Pillars, including: (1) Service above self to improve lives; (2) Member recruitment (to increase membership from the current 438 members to 460 members); (3) Member retention; (4) Focusing on the weekly luncheon meetings as one of the cores of the membership experience; and, (5) Communication of (the Club's) value and activities. President Kevin stated that each member can contribute to the Club's mission by recruiting a new member, donating to the Rotary Fund and Rotary Foundation, and providing feedback to officers.

President Kevin also recognized Rotarians Theresa Raidy, Lee Squires, Jenny Drake, Greg Braun, and the members of the Rockin' Rotary Band for their efforts in making last week's successful Rotary Reach Out event. Arne Judd, Vice President of Arrasmith, Judd, Rapp, Chovan, Inc. Architects, announced the students who were awarded Theodore Buerck Scholarships.

Julie Schmidt, Senior Director of External Affairs, KET, introduced our guest speaker, Bill Goodman. Bill Goodman is a native of Glasgow, Kentucky, graduated from Western Kentucky University and serves as the host of KET's *Kentucky Tonight* public affairs program. Bill Goodman began his presentation with a unique opening "on the trail." Goodman reflected on 50 years of history following his trip as a nine-year-old to the New York World's Fair and his association with former Vice President Al Gore, while both were reporters for *The* (Nashville) *Tennessean*. Journalism today is a mix of new and rapidly evolving technology which results in "instant" reporting of the news and breaking events. Goodman also commented on the need for real conversation and balanced reporting in the ongoing senate race between Senate Minority Leader Mitch McConnell and Secretary of State Alison Lundergan Grimes. Goodman acknowledged the ongoing difficulty in scheduling a debate (in any location/venue) between the two candidates; however, he expressed confidence that both will appear jointly sometime prior to the election on *Kentucky Tonight*! There being no further business, the meeting concluded with the recitation of the Rotary Four Way Test and was adjourned.
